FAQ - Answers to your frequently asked questions

- 1. My pledge reminder doesn't show my payment, why?**
There is always some lag time between when parishioners mail their payment to when we at the Diocese receive the information to be entered into our system and when we pull the mailing list for the reminders.
- 2. Why don't I see monthly BAA charges on my credit card bill?**
For security purposes the Diocese does not store credit card information and cannot charge multiple automatic payments. If a parishioner wishes to make payments over several months with a credit card or direct bank account withdrawal, they can do so on our website by clicking "Donate to the BAA Online".
- 3. I put my BAA money in the collection, why doesn't my pledge reminder show what I've paid?**
Keep track of any BAA payments that are mistakenly dropped in offertory and remind parishioners to send their BAA payments directly to the Atlanta lockbox.
