Grant Evaluation & Recommendation	<i>God's Work ~ Our Challenge Endowment for the Poor Grant Committee.</i> This Committee consists of five members serving staggered terms. Members are appointed by the Bishop of the Diocese of Raleigh.	
Purpose	This grant is to provide funding for projects related to apostolic works for the poor with special emphasis on minority ministries, especially African Americans and Hispanics. Priority will be given to those projects requesting seed money.	
Qualifying Organization	Any Catholic organization, or organization with Catholics serving on the Board of Directors or actively involved in the organization, with a 501(c)(3) certificate that serves the poor within the Diocese of Raleigh.	
Qualifying Activities	Awards are available for non-recurring funding for: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Development of programs supporting the poor • Development of programs advocating for the poor • Direct incremental disbursement to assist the poor and individuals in need 	
Examples of Previous Awards	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • School books and lunches for children relocated due to hurricane Katrina • Funding for a retreat program assisting families with tools for successful re-entry into family life after being deployed • Lodging for many families who were experiencing distress or in crisis • Funding to establish a collaborative effort between different religious organizations which provide food for the poor • Seed funding for a program which enriches the social and spiritual life of adults with physical disabilities

Grant Award Limit	Maximum grant is \$10,000
